NEIL ARMSTRONG

Monarch who reigned for 70 years, and served as a driver and mechanic in the Auxiliary Territorial Service during World War II.



SIR MICHAEL CAINE

Best known for portraying Wonder Woman, this actress served in the Israel Defense Forces as a combat instructor.



JOHNNY CASH

This actress from *Stranger Things* is a military veteran who served in the United States Navy as an aviation ordnanceman.



BLIPPI

This accomplished actor who played Kylo Ren served in the United States Marine Corps before pursuing a career in acting.



MORGAN FREEMAN

This iconic British actor completed his national service in the British Army during the Korean War.



ADAM DRIVER

The “King of Rock and Roll,” who served in the United States Army and was stationed in Germany.



ELVIS PRESLEY

This acclaimed actor and narrator served in the United States Air Force as a radar technician.



ICE-T

This popular children’s entertainer served in the United States Air Force as a fighter jet mechanic.
